### Resurrection Sunday — Two Services!

April kicked off with Resurrection Sunday! This year, we held two services — one at **6:00 AM** and one at **10:00 AM**. After the sunrise service, we had breakfast together and were blessed to have several **visitors** join us for the celebration. **Attendance throughout the month was incredible**, with our highest day of the month being April 19th, with **219** in attendance! Please pray with us that we can stay consistently above 200. We saw it happen in March, and we believe God is going to make it our new normal!

### Hospital Ministry — Souls Saved Every Sunday



Our Sunday night hospital ministry had an incredible month. Across four Sundays, our team served 341 meals and saw **65 people trust Christ** as Savior. The highlight of the month was our very first Sunday — April 5th — when 15 soul winners went out, and 17 people received the Lord. About 20 people attended, and **many of them enrolled in our discipleship program** and signed up for our small groups during the Sunday school hour.
